Regulations regarding private swimming pools and spas

Colac Otway Shire Council wishes to remind you of the strict rules which apply to private swimming pools and spas.

Building Regulations require <u>ALL</u> swimming pools, which are greater than 30cm (300mm or 1 foot) in depth, to have an inspected and approved pool safety barrier in place. These rules apply regardless of whether the swimming pool is permanent or temporary. It is the law to have an <u>inspected and approved</u> safety barrier around your pool or spa.

Municipal Waste Disposal

It is estimated that approximately 5000 tonnes of municipal waste would be delivered for disposal annually.

Wye River and Separation Creek Pits and Pipes Drainage Works

Contract No. RFT 1920

Council invites suitable tenders for the supply and installation of pits and pipes within Wye River and Separation Creek. Colac Otway Shire Council has developed an integrated stormwater management plan with careful consideration of the neighbourhood character and the requirement to address the issues of erosion control and slope stability.

This plan will control the stormwater in the townships by improving existing table drains, increasing capacity of driveway culverts, installing kerb and channel, sealing intersection and installing reticulated pits and pipes.
