Council's free immunisation sessions are held in Colac on the first Thursday and the third Monday of the month at COPACC and by appointment every Monday in Apollo Bay at the Kindergarten building located at the Apollo Bay P-12 College site on Pengilley Avenue.

Thursday 6 July, 10am - 11.30am

Council also has flu vaccine available for infants under five years of age and adults aged 65 and over. The flu vaccine for these age groups will be available at all Council immunisation sessions.

Valuation Averaging Mechanism Engage Vic Consultation

Local Government Victoria has initiated a public consultation to examine the merits of a Valuation Averaging Mechanism.

This consultation aligns with the supported recommendation from the 2020 Local Government Rating System Review Final Report and the Government's response, both of which were published in 2020. Recommendation 7 of the Final Report was that the Victorian Government examine the merits of a valuation averaging mechanism to reduce the impact of large changes in valuations on rates.

As part of this consultation process, a Discussion Paper has been prepared, including modelling of the potential impacts of a Valuation Averaging Mechanism. This paper aims to facilitate public understanding and solicit feedback to determine the merits of such a mechanism.
