


How to put on your PPE (donning)

SEQUENCE FOR PUTTING ON PPE

Put on PPE before patient contact and generally before entering the patient room


HAND HYGIENE

- Wash hands or use an alcohol based hand rub.



GOWN

- Fully cover torso from neck to knees, arms to end of wrists, and wrap around the back.
- Fasten at the back of neck and waist.




MASK

- Secure ties or elastic bands at middle of head and neck.




PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR OR FACE SHIELD

- Place over face and eyes and adjust to fit.



GLOVES

- Extend to cover wrist of isolation gown.
