## **Questions Received Verbally at the Meeting**

## Victoria Moore - Gerangamete

In light of a recent article in the Colac Herald regarding a bus operator's complaint with respect to the state of the existing public toilet, could the Shire consider a new public toilet for the north-east corner of the Memorial Square?

Why was the shopping complex located at the corner of Bromfield and Hesse Streets permitted to proceed without public toilet facilities given that the nearest public toilet is the comfort station located in Hesse Street and is difficult for parents with young children to access from that location?

Are Councillors aware that there is no public toilet with hot water and soap in Colac?

#### Response:

The Mayor thanked Ms Moore for her suggestions which would be taken on board and considered in line with budget considerations.

#### Questions Received in Writing Prior to the Meeting

#### Mr James Judd - Colac

1. 2 days equals 48 hours.

This is not close of business on Monday before the meeting is only the second day before the meeting not 2 days.

Amend your details contained in meeting agendas to stipulate the truth and not 2 days before the meeting.

#### Response:

As indicated the meeting agendas are available on the Monday before the meeting. The agendas are available Monday mornings both in hard copy where requested and on Council's website.

2. How can you advise bus services as "year round" when it is only for a limited time of under 10 months duration.

Two of five services advertised on Friday 3/12/2010 are in this position with no advice that they are subject to change from the period stated.

## Response:

To avoid confusion with summer timetables, two current Transport Connections bus trials are advertised as 'Year Round' as they offer weekly connections to Colac for local communities for an initial trial period of 1 year. The initial <u>starting date</u> has not been advertised with each update i.e. 1 July 2009 (Apollo Bay Wednesday bus) and 5 February 2010 (Lavers Hill - Beech Forest Friday bus)

Transport Connections bus trials are reviewed by the Department of Transport on an advertised 'use it or lose it' data collection basis. In response to these reviews, timetable updates occur, and the dates included are the updated period so travellers know that the timetable they are using is the most recent.

#### Damien Dureau - Colac

Would you please provide me with answers in writing to the following questions:-

- Re: New, replacement Apollo Bay Waste Transfer Station (completed November 2010)
- (a) What was the actual final total capital cost (including the land site purchase, and earthworks, etc.)?

#### Response:

The project still has some minor outstanding invoices to be paid, however, the total final cost of this project inclusive of land purchase, planning and development, legal, design and the building contract, is projected to be \$3,112,800.

- (b) How much of the amount at 1(a) above, came from:-
  - (i) Colac Otway Shire Council (COSC)'s own direct funds (including loan borrowings)?

## Response:

All but the \$200,000 Grant from Sustainability Victoria has been funded from Councils own direct funds.

(ii) Government Grant - Sustainability Victoria?

## Response:

Government Grant - Sustainability Victoria \$200,000

- 2. Re: Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector (completed October 2010)
- (a) What was the actual final total capital cost (including the total interior fit-out costs)?
- (b) How much of the amount at 2(a) above, came from:-
  - (i) COSC's **own direct funds** (including loan borrowings)?
  - (ii) Government Grant Federal Government (Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government)?

- (iii) Government Grants DPCD?
- (iv) Government Grant DEECD?
- (v) Post Compulsory Education Provider (and please specify the name of the actual funding source)?

#### Response:

Council's contribution to the construction of the new facility is \$2.921m as per the Joint Use Agreement.

- State Government Grants of \$1.5m
- Federal Government Grant of \$272,000
- Shire Funds of \$1.149m

As previously advised Council will contribute \$151,000 towards furniture and fittings. The total Shire's contribution of \$1.3 million is to be funded from Loan borrowings.

- 3. Re: Lakeside Estate former Waste Disposal site at Bruce Street, Colac (listed as a Report item in COSC Ordinary Meeting Minutes 24 March 2010)
  - (a) I understand that this matter is addressed "In-Committee", but is this matter still ongoing, or has it finally been resolved?

#### Response:

The matter has been dealt with "In-Committee", but has been finalised.

(b) If this matter is not yet resolved please confirm that when it is finally resolved that COSC will then make public disclosure of the details.

#### Response:

Further details are being sought from Council's solicitors.

**4. Re: New COSC Loan Borrowings of \$3.1 million** (approved in COSC Annual Budget 2009/2010 (with amendment motion))

#### Response:

Note, that as at 30 November 2010 only \$2,000,000 of the approved \$3,100,000 has been borrowed. This was borrowed in the 2009/10 financial year and Council will borrow the remaining \$1,100,000 as it is required.

The interest rate for the balance of the \$1.1million is at November 2010 to provide an indication of projected payments.

(a) What is the **projected total interest payments** on the \$1.5 million borrowings component for the "**Apollo Bay Waste Transfer Station**"; and what is the projected loan term in number of years, and the implied interest rate?

## Response

Fixed interest rate of 7.70% over a ten (10) year term for \$700,000 Projected total interest payments are \$305,884.96

Fixed interest rate of 7.81% over a ten (10) year term for \$800,000 Projected total interest payments are \$355,129.26

Total projected interest payments are \$661,014.22

(b) What is the projected total interest payments on the \$1.3 million borrowings component for the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector"; and what is the projected loan term in number of years, and the implied interest rate?

#### Response:

Fixed interest rate of 7.70% over a ten (10) year term for \$1,300,000 Projected total interest payments are \$568,072.07

(c) What is the **projected total interest payments** on the \$0.3 million borrowings component for the "**potential land purchase**"; and what is the projected loan term in number of years, and the implied interest rate?

#### Response:

Fixed interest rate of 7.81% over a ten (10) year term for \$300,000 Projected total interest payments are \$133,173.47

- (a) Please confirm that as per clauses 13.4(a), 13.4(b), 14.2(a) and 14.2(b) of the "Development and Joint Use Agreement" for the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector" that COSC will be paying for 50% of both "the operating costs" and "all maintenance and repair costs" of the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector", including, inter alia:-
  - (i) School Administration and Reception Area;
  - (ii) School Staff Room Area;
  - (iii) School Offices, Sick Bays, etc. Area.
- (b) What is the estimated annual total of "the operating costs" and "all maintenance and repair costs" (as defined under the "Development and Joint Use Agreement" at 5(a) above) of the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector"; and hence, what is COSC's estimated annual half-share of those costs?

#### Response:

Council will be paying 50% of the operating costs for the Colac Community Library and Learning Centre. Annual costs are yet to be determined.

- (c) Please confirm that as per clauses 13.6(a) and 14.2(c) and Item 13(b) of the Schedule of the "Development and Joint Use Agreement" for the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector" that, although considered and dealt with separately to "the operating costs" and "all maintenance and repair costs" (referred to at Question 5(a) above), COSC will also be paying for 50% of the building insurance cost for the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector", including, inter alia:-
  - (i) School Administration and Reception Area;
  - (ii) School Staff Room Area;
  - (iii) School Offices, Sick Bays, etc. Area.

#### Response:

Council will be paying 50% of the building insurance costs for the Colac Community Library and Learning Centre.

(d) What is the estimated annual total of the building insurance cost (referred to at Question 5(c) above) for the "Entire Building at Colac Secondary College formerly referred to as Global Connector"; and hence, what is COSC's estimated annual half-share of that cost?

The annual premium is yet to be calculated.
