5. QUESTION TIME

Questions Received in Writing Prior to the Meeting

James Judd - Colac

1. What portion of rates is needed to pay the cost of restoring infrastructure, public utilities and signage as a result of vandalism of shire property?

Response:

Approximately 0.16% of rates and municipal charges are expended annually on responding to vandalism of Council property.

Please note that this answer is only an approximate. It is very difficult to give an exact answer as it would take countless hours to track down each and every job and decide if it was vandalism or just wear and tear.

2. When will priority ranking of projects mean something in relation to when they will actually be done, not subject to continual revision and delays for something else to jump in priority and may never be done?

Response:

Priority ranking of projects is carried out in a robust, analytical manner and provides guidance regarding highest priority projects for Councillor consideration.

Many projects are carried out from the priority list annually, while some with lower priority in one year may gain higher priority in the following year because risk rating or other factors see them being reclassified.

The priority list can be seen as a ten year program and this allows better long term planning.

3. Why is there no uniform requirement as to when agendas are provided. With some last work day of a week before a meeting. This would be possible to only be morning of a meeting if called on another day.

Response:

This question has previously been answered. Special Council meeting agendas are prepared as soon as possible, but is dependent on when the meeting is called and the background information that is required to prepare the reports.

Under the Local Law an agenda for a special council meeting must be served on every Councillor at least 24 hours (including at least 1 working day) before the meeting.

4. How much money is spent per year to hire outside bodies to make reports to Council. Some contain blatant errors in dates. So how much else is accurate and not just spin.

Response:

We don't have a figure available and will not respond to unsubstantiated claims.

 Adoption of Colac CBD and Entrance Project. Please explain the claim on Page 65 in the first two lines of background. Another blunder: the project commenced late in 2012 after \$75,000 funding was received from RDV.

Since we are not midway into 2012 now. When will items be checked to make sure dates quoted are correct.

It is impossible to adopt something that has not commenced.

Response:

Noted.

6. In regard to the report Australia Day 2013. In view of the claim public safety: water on page 36 is a requirement when Australia Day Events are held. How do you explain Apollo Bay is acceptable for Australia Day 2013 Events. Since for many years severe water restrictions have applied over all summer months in Apollo Bay.

Response:

Council works with the local community groups and ensures that all guidelines with respect to public safety are adhered to.
