# Questions Received in Writing Prior to the Meeting

### Bernie Franke - Barramunga

1.In which year did Council become aware that some Otway blocks were considered to be unsuitable for development under the domestic wastewater rules adopted within the local planning scheme?

#### Response:

There has always been potential for some properties in the declared water catchments of the Otways to be unsuitable for development due to potential contamination of the drinking water supply. State Government guidelines specify requirements relating to new development in water catchments, and limit the density of development which may be permitted. Council Planning Officers encourage land owners to speak with the relevant water authority prior to purchasing land or lodging a planning permit for development to seek advice on these requirements, and to indicate whether an application may be supported.

#### Yvonne Francis – Apollo Bay

1. Will Council consider adding Montrose Avenue to the footpath strategy for Apollo Bay?

#### <u>Response:</u>

The Mayor advised that the request for a footpath in Montrose Avenue, Apollo Bay, was listed as an item for discussion in the Council agenda for today's meeting.

## Tony Webber - Otway Forum

1. Is Council going to debate the Apollo Bay Harbour Plan at the December Council meeting?

#### Response:

# Ben Wilminck - Apollo Bay

1. As per an article in the Weekly Times, it is now Council's responsibility to maintain the weeds in the front of landowners' properties so why is Council spraying the weeds in the drains and not grading them?

### Response:

The Acting CEO advised that Councils have been asked to prepare a weed control plan to determine what their weed control works will include. Council is currently working on a plan to determine what weed control works it can undertake within existing resources.

The Acting General Manager, Infrastructure & Services, advised that the spraying of weeds in drains is completed in the lead up to further grading works.

2. What about when the drains are within a catchment overlay? Are they allowed to spray drains in a catchment overlay?

## Response:

The Acting General Manager Infrastructure and Services advised that were no restrictions on the spraying of weeds in drains within a catchment overlay.

3. Council has sent notices to landholders reminding them of their responsibilities with respect to the slashing of grass in the lead up to the fire season, how is Council going to undertake the slashing of grass in laneways within the timelines given to landholders?

#### Response:

The Mayor advised that there had been a late start to Council's slashing program this year due to the wet conditions. However, slashing has started in the north of the Shire where conditions are the driest and the fire danger high. An extra tractor and slasher is being used and is working towards the south of the Shire.
