Planning and Environment Act 1987 COLAC OTWAY PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment C090cola

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C090cola to the Colac Otway Planning Scheme.

The Amendment implements the findings of the Deans Creek and Barongarook Creek Flood Study (2017) through changes to the Floodway Overlay (FO) and the Land Subject to Inundation Overlay (LSIO) maps and schedules to improve the performance of the Colac Otway Planning Scheme in responding to flood events in Colac and surrounds.

The amendment comes into operation from 30 July 2021.
