- EXISTING CAR PARK SPACES TO BE RETAINED
- EXISTING / PROPOSED LAWN AREAS AS NOTED
- INSTALL A BASKETBALL RING / AREA WITHIN THE COMMON AREA. THERE ARE TWO ALTERNATIVE LOCATIONS

INFRASTRUCTURE

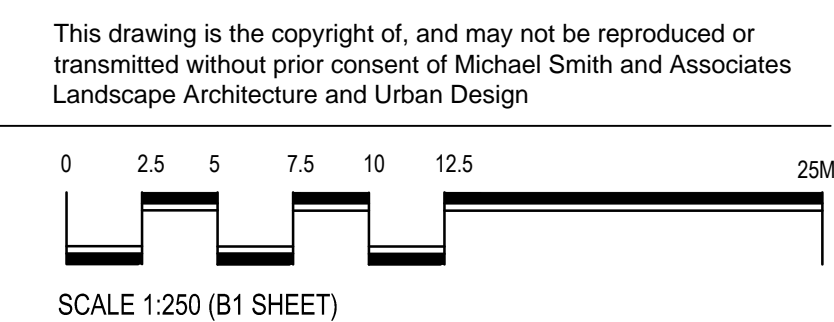
- Make the common more welcoming through artwork and signage.
- A** (A) Establish a display of indigenous people's artwork and stories, as a time line along the concrete circuit path. Provide interpretive information about the Forrest Railway Station and nearby Tiger Trail. Include artworks by local artisans to build on selected themes.
- Include interpretive signage along the concrete circuit path on information on the history of settlement and land use, the railways, timber mills, agriculture and bike trails.
- B** (B) Ultimately the improved playspace to Township standards is to cater for a wide range of age groups. Infill the existing swale and create a dry creek bed with sensory planting using indigenous plants.
- C** (C) Establish a bush foods garden associated with the time line trail
- D** (D) Establish a simple grass mounded amphitheatre to the southern end of the common with potential to sit 30-40 people on the grassed slope.
- E** (E) Construct a concrete kerb and channel to the east side of Station Street along the full length of the common to prevent the surcharge of street drainage water across the park
- F** (F) Replace the perimeter bollards along Station Street with a more modern style and remove bollards within the mid-section of the Common.
- G** (G) Create a flat area for a performance space and other activities to the existing flatter grassed area. The flat grassed area could be synthetic grass or green synthetic rubber, with drainage underneath
- H** (H) Provide seating with back and arm rests along the pathways
- I** (I) Construct a concrete circuit path 2.5 metres wide with timeline images
- J** (J) Install a basketball ring / area within the common area - Option A. This option is for the basketball ring and key to be to the edge of the tennis court and the tennis court fence to be extended into the park. Install some drainage pits. The exact location of the new basketball area to be proposed/determined by the community during the public exhibition timeframe of the Draft Masterplan
- K** (K) Install a basketball ring / area within the common area - Option B. The implementation of this option would have to wait for the completion of the playspace renewal. The exact location of the new basketball area to be proposed / determined by the community during the public exhibition timeframe of the Draft Masterplan.
