NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMIT

The application reference number is: PP252/2018-1.

The land affected by the application is located at: 3765 Great Ocean Road, WYE RIVER.

The application is for a permit to: Building and Works associated with the Replacement of the Telecommunication Monopole (15 metre telecommunications monopole with a triangular headframe).

The applicant for the permit is: Visionstream Pty Ltd.

Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the responsible authority.

An objection must be made to the responsible authority in writing and include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected.

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available at its office for any person to inspect during office hours free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before **1 July 2019.**

If you object the responsible authority will tell you its decision.
