Notice of Preparation of Amendment

Amendment C101cola

Colac Otway Shire Council has prepared Amendment C101cola.

The land affected by the Amendment is land covered by the Environmental Significance Overlays Schedule 1 (ESO1) and Schedule 2 (ESO2) in Colac Otway Shire.

The Amendment deletes the ESO1 (Warrion Groundwater Area) to the north of Colac and updates the mapping of ESO2 (Lakes, Wetlands and Watercourses) along the Barongarook and Deans Creeks in and around Colac.

Any person who may be affected by the Amendment may make a submission to the planning authority about the Amendment. Name and contact details of submitters are required for Council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend Council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. The closing date for submissions is **Thursday 20 February 2020**. Written submissions should be titled 'Amendment C101cola Submission' and emailed to ing@colacotway.vic.gov.au or posted to: Strategic Planning, Colac Otway Shire Council, PO Box 283, Colac, VIC 3250.

The planning authority must make a copy of every submission available at its office for any person to inspect, free of charge, for two months after the Amendment comes into operation or lapses.
