Changed traffic conditions on Colac-Ballarat Road, Irrewarra to affect access to Colac Regional Saleyards

There will be changes to access the Colac Regional Saleyards due to works and altered traffic conditions on the Colac-Ballarat Road from January 28 through to February 28.

The Colac-Ballarat Road will be closed from 6am to 6pm weekdays. On sale days, access to the saleyards will be from the Princes Highway end only.

No heavy vehicle traffic will be able to access the Colac-Ballarat Road from the northern (Ballarat) end. Detour signage will be in place to direct heavy vehicle traffic onto the Coragulac-Beeac Road/Corangamite Lake Road via Cororooke.

Traffic control will be in place to facilitate heavy vehicle traffic movements from the Princes Highway
