Colac Memorial Square Playspace Community Consultation

A new playspace is about to arrive at Memorial Square in 2021! Council has received \$550,000 in Federal and State Government funding to develop the playspace and will contribute \$50,000 to the project.

The design includes diverse and inclusive play elements, such as a wheelchair accessible carousel, sand play, musical instruments and a poppy themed play fort.
