Bridge (over Barongarook Creek) Replacement Works – Forest Street, Colac

Construction works for the Forest Street Bridge replacement project are now expected to commence in late July 2020 and continue through to late September 2020.

The scope of the project involves the removal and replacement of the existing bridge with new widened structure to better service current and future vehicle transport needs.

A traffic management plan for the construction works will involve a total road closure of Forest Street at the bridge site. A vehicle detour will be in effect for the duration of the construction works.

Public access to the Joseph Paatch Reserve carpark will also be unavailable during works as the area may be used as a contractor lay down yard and storage area from 20 July 2020 through to September 2020.
