Council's upcoming immunisation sessions will be held at COPACC, 95 -97 Gellibrand Street, Colac. Please use main entrance (all abilities access) via Gellibrand Street. Monday 19 October,

2.30pm - 4.30pm Thursday 5 November,

10.30am - 11.30am Social distancing measures will be in

place, hand sanitiser will be provided and only one parent/guardian should accompany a child into the session. People should not attend the session if they or their child has symptoms of a respiratory infection (such as fever, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath, cough) or have recently returned from overseas.

Immunisation is a simple, safe and effective way of protecting children against certain diseases.

- free immunisation
- no appointment necessary • availability after school for secondary school catch-up
- experienced nurse immunisers who can discuss any questions parents may have
