**Thursday 5 November,
10.30am - 11.30am**

Social distancing measures will be in place, hand sanitiser will be provided and only one parent/guardian should accompany a child into the session. People should not attend the session if they or their child has symptoms of a respiratory infection (such as fever, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath, cough) or have recently returned from overseas.

Immunisation is a simple, safe and effective way of protecting children against certain diseases.

- free immunisation
- no appointment necessary
- availability after school for secondary school catch-up
- experienced nurse immunisers who can discuss any questions parents may have
- next day upload to the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register to ensure continuity of benefit payments and issue of school enrolment certificates.

A - Z Guide for your Green Bin FOGO bin

The last Colac Otway Shire bin audit showed that 30% of food was still ending up in general waste (Red Bin) and not in the Green Bin.

Our Colac Otway community does an excellent job at separating out organic waste, with only a .41% contamination rate in the Green Bins.

Please place your food waste in loose, wrap it in newspaper or use a certified compostable bag or liner.
