Flu Vaccinations will also be available free of charge (subject to availability) for:

- Children aged 6 months to 5 years
- Adults aged over 65

(If you fall into the over 65 age group category, please contact Council's Immunisation team to check the vaccine is available).

Social distancing measures will be in place, hand sanitiser will be provided and only one parent/guardian should accompany a child into the session. People should not attend the session if they or their child are unwell.

Immunisation is a simple, safe and effective way of protecting children against certain diseases.
