Do I need a building permit for a shipping container?

Colac Otway Shire Council reminds residents to obtain a Building Permit prior to placing a shipping container on their land.

The Victorian Building Authority advises that steel shipping containers being placed on properties to be used as storage sheds and other uses, are not exempt from obtaining a Building Permit.

Shipping containers, like all other building work, must comply with all the requirements of the Building Act, Building Regulations and National Construction Code that apply to that particular use, including obtaining a Building Permit, prior to being placed on the property.

Depending on the zoning of the land in the Planning Scheme, a Planning Permit may also be required.

Road Condition Inspection

Council will be undertaking an assessment of the Shire's 566km network of sealed roads.

Inspection work began Wednesday 22 September and will take approximately three weeks to complete.

You may observe camera equipped, transporter style inspection vehicles traveling on local roads around the municipality during this period; vehicles are clearly identifiable.

All cameras are focused on the road and kerb surface structure with some limited viewing of areas directly adjacent. No image recordings of commercial or residential, private properties or structures will be undertaken.

This inspection will provide information to assist in effective maintenance and renewal strategies of Council's sealed road network to improve connectivity and safety.
