Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, the October 2021 meeting will be held online with all participants to dial in via videoconference.





Colac Civic Health and Rail Precinct Plan

Council is seeking input from stakeholders, community groups and individuals into the Colac Civic Health and Rail Precinct Plan, which addresses land use and infrastructure in the precinct, with a callout for members of the community to attend a series of planning workshops running in November.

The Precinct Plan seeks to improve accessibility and connectivity, including car parking, throughout the precinct, with the workshops aiming to identify the community's vision and aspirations for key facilities and services, such as COPACC, the Colac Train Station, Colac Otway Shire Council's administration offices and the Colac Hospital (Colac Area Health).

Additional Green Waste Collection through to November

Council's weekly green waste collection is happening now through to mid/ late November (subject to your collection week) to help you clean up your property and prepare for fire season.

When your red bin goes out, put your green bin out too.


The purple bin is coming to a Colac Otway kerbside near you!

Colac Otway Shire Council has started delivering the new purple 'glass only' bins to properties that receive a kerbside waste collection in the shire.

The bins will be delivered over the next four weeks, so if you haven't received one yet, it won't be too far away! Collection of the purple bin will start in November

(when purple bins have been delivered to all properties). When collection starts, your purple bin will be collected

every four weeks on the same day as your yellow (recycling) bin (your yellow bin will continue to be collected fortniahtly).



- Waste calendars with purple bin collection dates are included with your rates notice.
- You can look up waste calendars any time on Council's website.

Green Waste Skips - Wye River and Kennett River

Skips for green waste (only) will once again be placed at Wye River and Kennett River to assist residents to clean-up their property in preparation for fire season.

The green waste skips will be at the same locations as last year:

1A The Boulevarde Wye River (opposite the CFA shed) 15A Great Ocean Rd Kennett River (carpark area)

In 2020, our coastal communities disposed of 19 tonnes of green waste with no reports of contamination - a fantastic result!



Upcoming weed control works - Barongarook Creek, Murray Street to Lake Colac

Council will undertake weed control works along the riparian zone over the coming weeks.

Council's weed control in this area predominantly involves hand-weeding, however the conditions this season have favoured strong weed growth that will require some herbicide application.
