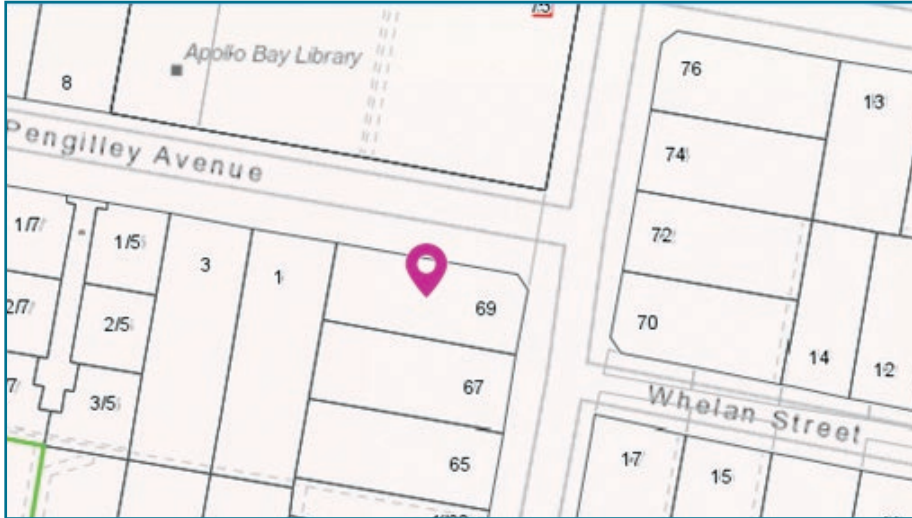

Colac Otway Shire Council HEREBY gives notice under Section 114 of the Local Government Act 2020 (the Act) that it proposes to sell the land as shown below.



On 27 October 2021, at the monthly Council Meeting, Colac Otway Shire Council, resolved to advertise its intention to sell the land at 69 McLachlan Street, Apollo Bay, more particularly described in Certificate of Title Volume 7792 Folio 029.

Colac Otway Draft Public Toilet Strategy

Colac Otway Shire Council has developed its first Draft Public Toilet Strategy to guide investment and decision making about the provision, management and maintenance of public toilet facilities in the municipality over the next 10 years.



The Strategy will help to focus Council investment in public toilet facilities that provide a demonstrated community benefit, including to the local economy, ensuring they are provided where they are needed most. Through the Strategy, Council will also advocate for and support the provision of facilities by other managing authorities at key tourist destinations, to meet the needs of regional and international visitation.

A registration system will be in place for members of the public wishing to attend the Special Council meeting in person. To ensure COVID-19 capacity restrictions are adhered to, the number of people permitted to attend will be capped according to the room size. Any person who would like to come along to the Special Council meeting must register by contacting Council via email on governance@colacotway.vic.gov.au or phone 5232 9400 before close of business (5pm) Monday 8 November 2021. Registrations will open today, Friday 5 November. If attendance capacity is reached, community members will be advised if their registration has been unsuccessful.

In response to current COVID-19 requirements as directed by the Chief Health Officer, all attendees aged 16 and over must be fully vaccinated and show their vaccination status as a condition of entry to COPACC. Patrons will be required to enter COPACC via the main entrance (all abilities access from Gellibrand Street), where they will be required to register and show proof of vaccination.

News on Waste & Recycling

Green Waste Skips - Wye River and Kennett River and Free Green Waste Drop-off at Transfer Stations in Apollo Bay and Alvie

Skips for green waste (only) have again been placed at Wye River and Kennett River to assist residents to clean-up their property in preparation for fire season. Skips will be in place from Monday 1 November through to Friday 26 November.

The green waste skips are at the same locations as last year:

1A The Boulevard Wye River (opposite the CFA shed)

15A Great Ocean Rd Kennett River (carpark area)

Please note, skips are for lighter green waste. Heavier green waste (large branches, cut trees) should be taken to the Apollo Bay Transfer Station. Council is offering a free green waste drop-off service at Apollo Bay and Alvie transfer stations through to Friday 26 November. The free service will be available to residents to dispose of one 6 x 4 trailer of green waste.

Additional Green Waste Collection through to November

Council's weekly green waste collection is happening now through to mid/late November (subject to your collection week) to help you clean up your property and prepare for fire season.

When your red bin goes out, put your green bin out too.



The purple bin is coming to a Colac Otway kerbside near you!

Colac Otway Shire Council has started delivering the new purple 'glass only' bins to properties that receive a kerbside waste collection in the shire.



The bins will be delivered over the next four weeks, so if you haven't received one yet, it won't be too far away!

Collection of the purple bin will start in November (when purple bins have been delivered to all properties).

When collection starts, your purple bin will be collected every four weeks on the same day as your yellow (recycling) bin (your yellow bin will continue to be collected fortnightly).

How will you know when the purple bin collection starts?

- Waste calendars with purple bin collection dates are included with your rates notice.
- You can look up waste calendars any time on Council's website.
