What is E-waste?

E-waste or electronic waste, is any item with a plug, battery or power cord.

Correct Disposal of E-waste

A reminder to please take your e-waste and hazardous materials to a drop-off centre rather than putting it into any kerbside bins. It's FREE to dispose of at all Council operated transfer stations (see our website or the GoodSort app for more details).

Putting e-waste and hazardous material into kerbside bins can start fires and endanger staff, including if a fire starts in one of the waste collection trucks.
