Memorial Square Public Toilet Redevelopment - Concept Plans for Community Feedback

The Memorial Square Public Toilet redevelopment is an important community project that will see the replacement of the existing toilets with a new and improved facility.

The project aims to create a high quality facility that caters to people of all ages and abilities.

The draft design features Colac Otway Shire's first Changing Places Facility (a customised adult change facility), family room with baby change table and junior toilet, separate accessible cubicle and an increase from 5 toilets to 14. All cubicles in the new facility will be gender neutral (with the exception of the urinals).
