



### PARTICIPATION

The statements below represent a summary of Tennis Victoria registered participant statistics for the 2012/13 year.

- ▶ Tennis Victoria registered participants have decreased by 22% from 4,378 in 2010/11 to 3,394 registered participants (-982) in 2012/13.
- ▶ The most significant losses occurred in the 2010/11 year.
- ▶ There is an equitable balance of female participation in tennis across the G21 region representing 46% of all 2012/13 Tennis Victoria registered participants (54% male participants).
- ▶ Greater Geelong provided 70% of 2012/13 registered participants, followed by Surf Coast (11%), Colac Otway (11%), Golden Plains (7%) and Queenscliffe (1%).
- ▶ The localities with the strongest existing tennis participation in the region were Central, Southern and Eastern Geelong postcode areas (3216, 3219, 3220) and Ocean Grove (3226).
- ▶ North Geelong, the Bellarine Peninsula and Aireys Inlet / Fairhaven areas also identified stronger levels of participation than the remainder of the region.
- ▶ Tennis Australia reported 2,653 registered MLC Tennis Hot Shots participants in 2012/13 in the region and 45 Cardio Tennis participants.
- ▶ 1.48% of the 2013 G21 regional population were registered with Tennis Victoria (1:65 people).

### CLUB AND FACILITY NETWORK

Club network figures below represent all known tennis clubs operating within the G21 region.

- ▶ In 2012/13 there were 89 tennis clubs operating in the region at 105 operational tennis venues.
- ▶ The 105 operational tennis venues provide 402 usable tennis courts. Greater Geelong (53% of total usable courts), Colac Otway (18%), Golden Plains (14%), Surf Coast (13%) and Queenscliffe (2%).
- ▶ 31% of playable tennis courts have floodlighting. There is a significant shortfall of floodlit courts in the region, well below ideal minimums of between 50% to 75% of courts.
- ▶ The region provides 2 indoor tennis centres in Colac and North Geelong.
- ▶ The region provides 8 venues providing 8 or more courts (7.6% of venues) - 6 are based in Greater Geelong, 1 in Anglesea and 1 in Colac.
- ▶ 40% of existing tennis courts provide a recognised Tennis Australia player development surface (red porous/clay, natural grass or acrylic hard court).
- ▶ 63% of G21 based clubs (56 of 89) clubs) are affiliated with Tennis Victoria - this is well below the state average of 75%.
- ▶ 72 was the average reported Tennis Victoria affiliated club membership for 2012/13. Only 6 clubs had memberships of greater than 100.
- ▶ 54% of affiliated tennis clubs reported an increase in membership in 2012/13 from the previous year.

### STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

In 2014 the G21 Regional Tennis Strategy was completed and a number of regional focus areas were identified to support the growth and development of tennis. These were:

- ▶ STRUCTURE OF TENNIS
- ▶ PARTICIPATION
- ▶ FACILITY PROVISION & RENEWAL
- ▶ CLUB SUPPORT & DEVELOPMENT
- ▶ SERVICING AND DELIVERY

### GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT

#### HISTORICAL INVESTMENT

- ▶ In the 2013/14 financial year G21 LGA's delivered \$849,000 worth of tennis infrastructure projects, 82% of funding was provided through Local (72%) and State Government (10%).
- ▶ 18% of investment was provided through tennis clubs, community and Tennis Australia sources - totalling \$152,000.
- ▶ 1 Tennis Australia Court Rebate Scheme funded project to the value of \$32,000 was delivered in 2013/14.

**TENNIS VICTORIA REGISTRATIONS HAVE DECREASED BY 22% IN THE PAST THREE YEARS DUE TO DECLINING CLUB AFFILIATION, REDUCTION IN POPULARITY OF FORMAL COMPETITIONS AND MOVE TOWARDS MORE COACH PROGRAM LED PARTICIPATION.**

Participation in sport across the G21 region has *changed significantly* in recent years and there is a need to measure and monitor it's progress.

There is *equitable female participation in tennis across the region representing 46%* of all Tennis Victoria registered participants (54% male participants in 2012/13).





G21 REGION PERCENTAGE (%) OF TOTAL FLOODLIT COURTS BY LGA IN THE G21 REGION (2013)









### PURPOSE

The purpose of this annual State Of Play Report is to analyse and represent meaningful information to all levels of government, sporting organisations and the wider G21 community using existing regional and local tennis participation, club, facility and development information.

The State Of Play Report provides an overview of:

- ▶ Player statistics and demographics for the region,
- ▶ Club facility and registration data,
- ▶ Commentary from Tennis Victoria and Tennis Australia on the state of local clubs and the future directions and strategic initiatives of the sport, and
- ▶ Information on capital investment into local tennis facilities and other key projects.

### BENEFITS AND USES

The State of Play Report provides a variety of key benefits and diverse uses. It allows partners to:

- ▶ Measure, monitor and report on participation trends across the G21 region year on year.
- ▶ Visually and easily identify sport trends, local issues and opportunities.
- ▶ Strategically allocate resources and specifically target areas for future development.
- ▶ Measure and quantify impacts of investment, programs and initiatives.

2013 provides baseline data for tennis in the G21 region and enables partners to monitor and quantify change across a number of key participation indicators year-on-year.

### DATA SOURCES

Participant and Coach Registration Data was provided by Tennis Victoria and Tennis Australia.

Population data was sourced from the Department of Planning, Transport and Local Infrastructure, Victoria In Future population statistics, 2014.

Facility Location Data (2013) was sourced from Tennis Victoria and specific site visits conducted in 2013.
