Notice of Road Works and Pavement Stabilisation Works

Colac Otway Shire Council advises the following road reconstruction works are programmed to be undertaken:

Location: Stewart Street, Colac (between Wilson and Wheal streets)

Works: Road reconstruction works

Duration: Work is scheduled to commence 25 January 2022 with works expected to be completed by the end of March 2022.

The section of Stewart Street between Wilson and Wheal streets will be closed to through traffic while work is undertaken with one lane of the road open to local residents (only). Road users are asked to seek an alternative route and asked to take care and observe warning signs and other traffic control measures in place.

Affected residents will receive prior notification of works to minimise any inconvenience.

Reminder - 2021-22 Rates Payments Due

Ratepayers who have elected to pay their 2021-22 rates by the quarterly Instalments option are reminded the 3rd quarterly instalment is due to be paid by 28 February 2022; and notices for this instalment are being sent out. Ratepayers who have not activated the quarterly instalment option but would like to pay by this option (to allow extra time to pay), are asked to contact

Council's Revenue Department by calling 5232 9400. Ratepayers experiencing financial difficulty should also contact Council's Revenue Department to discuss an arrangement and prevent the account being referred to debt collectors.

Machinery, cars and vehicles can start grassfires

Grassfires can start and spread quickly. During the Fire Danger Period, if you're using machinery with an internal combustion or heat engine, such as tractors or slashers, within nine metres of grass, crops, stubble, weeds or other vegetation, it's important that you ensure the machinery is:

- Free from any faults and mechanical defects that could start a fire.
- Fitted with an approved spark arrestor.

• Carrying a working water fire extinguisher or knapsack of at least nine litres capacity.

In addition to water required under legislation, you should also carry a dry chemical extinguisher that is suitable for normal combustible fires and electrical fires, such as an ABE extinguisher, on machinery.

Avoid driving vehicles and motorbikes through dry grass. the risk of starting a fire from the hot exhaust system is high. Even pulling over into grass at the side of the road could start a serious grassfire without you even being aware.
