Background

Council adopted the dates for 2011 Council meetings in December 2010. The March Council meeting was scheduled to be held on the 23 March 2011. Since that time, the Mayor has been invited to meet with Federal Government Ministers in Canberra on the 23 March 2011. Given the importance of these meetings, it has been decided to move the March Council meeting to the 30 March 2011.
