***Location of utility assets (Note 1):**

The location for the western entrance to Colac will be on the northern side of the highway at approximately 431-437 Princes Highway as shown in the images on the accompanying document (CrossXpollinationN - Signage on a Road Reserve - Information). The signage at the eastern entrance is at approximately 6415 Princes Highway as shown in the images in the accompanying document. The location for the signage at the Northern entrance is at approximately 22-30 Colac - Lavers Hill Rd as shown in detail in the images in the attached document. Nearby intersections are also shown in this document.

***Description of works (Note 2):**

All three signs will be installed by staff who park safely off the road, wear high visibility vests and remain well off the road (including behind barriers were present - eastern entrance). These signs are corflute and will be attached to wooden stakes. They are temporary signs to display information about the annual CrossXpollinationN Textile and Fibre Art Exhibition held at COPACC. The signs will be removed using the same safety protocols. Consideration has also been given to proximity to speed change signage and all signs are safe from potentially distracting drivers from such speed changes.
