Primary Producer Support Payment Program

Colac Otway Shire Council is offering direct financial relief for local farmers through the Primary Producer Support Payment Program, part of the Victorian Government's Drought Support Package.

What's Happening?

Properties classified as 'Rural Farm' within the Colac Otway Shire will automatically receive a one-off 40% credit on their 2025-26 Council Rates, covering both their General Rates and Municipal Charge.

No Application Needed!

If your property is assessed as 'Rural Farm', the 40% credit will automatically appear on your rates notice as: "Primary Producer Support Payment - Rates Credit"

Rates notices for the 2025-26 financial year are in the process of being sent out to the community.

Why This Matters

This one-off support, totalling over \$2.8 million in Colac Otway Shire, recognises the impact of prolonged drought conditions on farmers and aims to ease financial pressure on our farming community.
