The September 2020 Council meeting will be held on:

Wednesday 16 September, 4pm at COPACC, Gellibrand Street, Colac. Agenda items include:

The Communities Combating Pests and Weeds grant opportunity for spring and early summer 2020 is now available with a new closing date for submissions to Council by 4pm Wednesday 16 September. The grant enables Council to support private property owners across the shire in their efforts to control weeds and rabbits on their properties.

The grant program requires private landowners to contribute a dollar for dollar amount equivalent to what they receive through the grant for works on their land.
