Colac Civic Rail and Health Precinct Plan

Contract No. 2106

Colac Otway Shire Council is seeking submissions from suitably qualified professionals for the provision of comprehensive consultancy services to prepare the Colac Civic Health and Rail Precinct Plan (the Precinct Plan). Council is partnering with Colac Area Health (CAH), VicTrack, and the Department of Transport (DOT) to develop a Precinct Plan. The project is a Council and G21 Priority Project under the Economic Development Pillar. The Precinct Plan will consider land use, built form, and infrastructure requirements for the whole precinct including its three main sub-precincts (health services, Civic (Colac Otway Shire offices and COPACC), and Colac station). It will include a masterplan for the area to guide public realm improvements and built form outcomes for future development.
