


No-interest period on rates extended

Colac Otway Shire Council has extended its no-interest period on Council rates to June 30, 2021 to assist ratepayers hard hit by the impact of COVID19.

However, Council is urging ratepayers experiencing financial difficulties as a result of this year's COVID19 situation and unable to make rates payments, to contact Council and discuss payment options.

Council encourages ratepayers with unpaid rates, or who are concerned they will struggle to pay upcoming quarterly instalments, or the full amount in February, to call Council now on 5232 9400 and discuss payment options.
