Notice of Expression of Interest for Forrest Caravan Park Lease

On 24 June 2021, at the June Council meeting, Colac Otway Shire Council resolved to advertise its intention to receive Expression Of Interests (EOI) to lease part of the land and buildings at 1 Station Street, Forrest more particularly described as Lot 1 of Title Plan 572740 and Lot1 on Title Plan 613717. Council is seeking EOIs from suitable caravan park operators, developers and entrepreneurs to operate and potentially develop the Forrest Caravan Park with the aim of seeking to secure a tenant from 28 April 2022.

Council thanks the Forrest community for their feedback on the future of Forrest Caravan Park during community consultation conducted in 2020. The results from consultation are available in the Forrest Caravan Park EOI report in the June Council Meeting agenda which may be found on Council's website and was used to inform the EOI document.

Council 2021/22 Budget Adopted

Colac Otway Shire Council has adopted its 2021/22 Budget following considerable community consultation and review. This budget enables delivery of important Council services and meets community expectations, with a focus on sustainability and infrastructure.

Key features from the 2021/22 Budget:

- A 1.5% average rate rise
- Reducing the proposed increase in the fortnightly kerbside waste collection charge to \$235
- Major changes to kerbside recycling services including a fourth bin to accommodate glass
- \$13.7m capital works program, including \$7m for roads and bridges
- Deans Creek Precinct Structure Plan to support Colac's residential growth
- Improved library services through transition to Geelong Regional Library Corporation
