Bruce Street Residential Development Project

Colac Otway Shire Council is seeking Expressions of Interest (Eol) from proponents with the qualifications, experience and capacity to purchase, and develop the land known as 36-52 Bruce Street, Colac VIC for residential use. The land is zoned General Residential Zone GRZ1 and is approximately 4.2 hectares (ha) in size.

Council invites submissions from:

- Developers of land in partnership with a home builder and/or Registered Housing Association/Provider;
- Home and Land developers in partnership with a Registered Housing Association/Provider; or
- Registered Housing Association/Provider.
