

Amazing work Colac Otway! You've captured so many aspects of our beautiful region and shown how great it is to live, work and play in Colac Otway.



Notice of an Application for Planning Permit

The land affected by the application is located at: 30 Lang Street BEEAC

You may look at the application and any documents that support the application at the office of the responsible authority during office hours at Colac Otway Shire Council's customer service centres in Colac (2-6 Rae Street) and 100 Great Ocean Road, Apollo Bay; or at http://www.colacotway.vic.gov.au This can be done during office hours and is free of charge.

Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the responsible authority.

An objection must be made to the responsible authority in writing, include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected.

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available at its office for any person to inspect during office hours free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before 21 October

If you object the responsible authority will tell you its decision.
