Road improvements for the road rail interface

Please note the following road closure due to road and safety improvements to the road rail interface.

Back Larpent Road, Larpent

Road Closure: Back Larpent Road will be closed to through traffic between Deans Creek Road and Larpent Road, Larpent from Monday 21 November 2022.

Access: Properties on the west-side of the railway line will need use Larpent Road for access. Properties on the east-side will need to use Deans Creek Road for access.

When the road is closed local property access will be available, however there will be no access over the rail line.

Back Larpent Road will reopen to traffic on Friday 25 November (subject to favourable weather conditions).

Road users are advised to take care and observe warning signs and other traffic control measures in place. Thank you for your cooperation while these important works are undertaken.

Murray Street, Colac - Footpath Cleaning

Pressure cleaning works will be completed in Murray Street, Colac.
