News on Waste and Recycling Services over Christmas and New Year

Kerbside waste collections

There are no changes to kerbside collections over Christmas and New Year (with the exception of extra yellow bin collections, see below). Please put your bins out on your regular collection days.

Extra recycling collections

Council's weekly yellow recycling bin collection will be happening again for Christmas and the summer holiday period. Yellow bins are for recycling paper/cardboard, hard plastics and aluminium/steel Extra yellow bin collections start:

- Monday 19 December for Week Two collection areas (finishing Friday 20 January) and
- Monday 26 December for Week One collection areas (finishing Friday 27 January).

If you're not sure which collection week you are, visit Council's website and search 'When Will My Bin Be Collected' or download the Good Sort App. The Good Sort App provides you with handy reminders for when to put your bins out and information on what goes in which bin. Over the summer holidays, Council will have an announcement on the App to remind residents of the extra collections.

Free Glass Drop-Off

For disposal of extra glass over the summer holidays (over Christmas to the end of January), Council is offering FREE glass disposal at the Alvie, Apollo Bay and Birregurra Transfer Stations. This free disposal is also available at the four Council Drop-Off Facilities at Beech Forest, Carlisle River, Gellibrand and Lavers Hill.
