An objection must be made to the responsible authority in writing, include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected.

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available at its office for any person to inspect during office hours free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before 17 February 2023. If you object the responsible authority will tell you its decision.

G - Grants

Last year in the 2022 - 2023 Grants Program, Council awarded \$311,500 to 84 community organisations, clubs, event organisers and businesses. The Grants Program provides an opportunity for a wide range of organisations and businesses to share in funding for a variety of projects and events within the shire. H - Health **Protection**

Council's Health Protection team cover a range of services and operations to ensure the health and safety of businesses and community in Colac Otway Shire. Did you know that free Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) are now available from various places in the Shire? You can collect up to two packs of RATs per person (or 2 packs per household member) from Council's Customer Service Centres in Colac and Apollo Bay, the Colac Visitor Information Centre and Colac and Apollo Bay Libraries. Visit Council's website for more information.

Council's free immunisation sessions are held in Colac on the first Thursday and the third Monday of the month at COPACC and by appointment every Monday in Apollo Bay at the Kindergarten on Pengilley Avenue. Council also manages the free immunisation service for Year 7 and 10 students in the Shire, our Health Protection team have an upcoming visit to Colac, Lavers Hill and Apollo Bay schools for this service in March.



Reminder, 2022 - 2023 Rates Payments Due

Please note, ratepayers who elected to pay their 2022 - 2023 Council rates by the lump sum method are reminded the full amount is due to be paid by 15 February 2023.

Ratepayers who have elected to pay their 2022 - 2023 rates by the quarterly instalment option are reminded the 3rd quarterly instalment is due to be paid by 28 February 2023 - notices for this instalment are being sent out.


