Local Law Review - Community engagement

Local Laws are designed to keep our community safe, protect public assets and enhance amenity within the shire.

The Local Laws Review project seeks to review Council's existing Local Laws 1, 2 and 3 with a view to integrate the three local laws into a single contemporary Local Law designed to improve and protect the amenity of the shire.



Objectives of the Local Laws Review aim to remove unnecessary or unused provisions and introduce new provisions to address any issues and identified deficiencies in the current Local Laws.

Community members are invited to provide feedback on the Local Law via an online survey - visit Council's website and click Have Your Say from the homepage (click to Local Law Review).

This can be done during office hours and is free of charge.

Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the responsible authority.

An objection must be made to the responsible authority in writing, include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available at its office for any person to inspect during office hours free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before 24 April 2023.

If you object the responsible authority will tell you its decision.
