3.5% average rate increase



Each \$100 of expenditure in Council's budget for 2023-24 financial year is allocated as follows:





\$83 will be spent delivering Council's regular services and





activities (recurrent operations).

62 new projects



\$17 will be committed to new initiatives (capital and operational projects).

Written submission must be received by 5pm on Monday 5 June 2023.

Submitters should note that unless a submitter requests to the contrary, copies of submissions (including submitter's name) may also be included in the Council meeting agenda, which are a permanent public record, and published on Council's website for an indefinite period.
