Community Care Review

At its meeting on Wednesday 3 May 2023, Council resolved to proceed with next steps in conducting a Best Value Review of Council's aged and disability services.

The Commonwealth Government has announced a new national system for aged care that will be implemented from 1 July 2025. The new system will introduce significant changes that have the potential to impact Council's capacity to deliver high quality aged and disability services to the community.

The Best Value Review will report on Council's delivery of home and community care services to assist older people, those recovering from acute care and people with disabilities to continue to live independently in the community, including the Commonwealth Home Support Program and Home and Community Care for Younger People Program.

Council endorsed the outcomes, objectives and governance arrangements outlined in the Best Value Review Project Plan, as published in the Council meeting agenda, and will proceed with the process of appointing an external consultant to ensure Council has the necessary information to make a decision at the conclusion of the review.

Consultation with the community will be a critical part of the process of the Best Value Review. It is important for Council to get the views and thoughts of staff, clients and family members, to ensure a fully informed review. A range of opportunities will be provided for people to have their say during the process.
