electric vehicles and a desire to deliver on environmental strategies with the introduction of new electric vehicle chargers in Apollo Bay and plans for more in Colac.

A key objective of Council's Environmental Sustainability Strategy is to encourage community efforts to transition to a zero-carbon environment, including the electrification of transport and enhanced public transport services across the region.

The electric vehicle chargers in Apollo Bay will be followed up by installation of new charger stations in Johnstone's Carpark in Colac in April - May.
