



Changes to Council immunisation sessions

From Monday 15 July you will need to book your child's immunisation session through the Victorian Department of Health - Central Immunisation Records Victoria (CIRV) booking portal.

If you haven't used CIRV before, you will need to create an account the first time you use this booking session.

To book your immunisation visit: https://portal.cirv.vic.gov.au/ click on book a community immunisation appointment then follow the steps to create a new account.

Council's free immunisation sessions take place on the third Monday and the first Thursday of each month and every Monday in Apollo Bay at the Apollo Bay Kindergarten at the P-12 College site (Apollo Bay sessions do not need to be booked online).

Upcoming childhood immunisation sessions at COPACC in Colac are:

- Monday 15 July, 2.30pm 4.30pm
- Thursday 1 August, 10am 11.30am

Flu vaccine is also available at these sessions for children aged between six months and five years and people aged 65 and older.

Local Government election - October 2024

In October 2024 Victorian local councils. including Colac Otway Shire will go to election.

The rules for council-enrolled voters have changed ahead of the 2024 council elections - find out if you need to enrol with Colac Otway Shire Council to vote. In a Victorian local council election there are two types of voters:

- 1. State-enrolled (automatically enrolled to vote in the 2024 Colac Otway Shire Council elections).
- 2. Council-enrolled (must apply to be enrolled and include owner ratepayers, occupier ratepayers and corporation representatives).

Some ratepayers can apply to become councilenrolled voters in Colac Otway Shire if they are:

- · a property owner, occupier or represent a corporation
- 18 years or older on election day (26 October 2024)
- not a State-enrolled voter within the Colac Otway Shire area.

All enrolment forms must be received by Council no later than 4pm on Wednesday 7 August 2024.

You can only vote once in each municipality, no matter how many properties you own or occupy.
