Immunisation sessions | October

Council's free monthly immunisation sessions are held on the first Thursday and the third Monday of the month at COPACC, 95-97 Gellibrand Street, Colac (via main entry at Gellibrand Street).

Thursday 1 October, 10.30am - 11.30am Monday 19 October, 2.30pm - 4.30pm

Social distancing measures will be in place, hand sanitiser will be provided and only one parent/ guardian should accompany a child into the session. People should not attend the session if they or their child has symptoms of a respiratory infection (such as fever, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath, cough) or have recently returned from overseas.

Immunisation is a simple, safe and effective way of protecting children against certain diseases.

Colac Otway Shire Council immunisation team provides:

- · free immunisation
- no appointment necessary
- · availability after school for secondary school catch-up
- · experienced nurse immunisers who can discuss any questions parents may have
- next day upload to the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register to ensure continuity of benefit payments and issue of school enrolment certificates.
