# Cororooke Playspace & Paths Funded

Colac Otway Shire Council has accepted a \$250,000 grant through the 2020-21 Local Sports Infrastructure Fund for the Cororooke Open Space – Path Network and Playspace project.

Council will allocate matching funding of \$250,000 from its Strategic Projects Reserve to the Cororooke project which involves the implementation of stages one and three of the Cororooke Open Space Master Plan.

Council has also accepted a further \$30,000 through the 2020-21 Local Sports Infrastructure Fund towards the Colac City Reserves Planning project and will allocate the required Council funding of \$50,000 from the Strategic Projects Reserve.

The reserve planning project will guide the preparation of site-specific master plans for Colac's Central Reserve, Eastern Reserve, Western Reserve and Lake Oval.



# Council to consider hardwaste collection

Colac Otway Shire Council will consider delivering a hardwaste collection service in 2021-22, with further investigation into collection options underway.

Council officers will develop a business case for the proposed service, following Council's consideration of the results of a community survey which indicated that residents wanted Council to provide a hardwaste collection.

The business case will provide details of how the collection can be delivered and funding of the service, which will be finalised in time for the new Council to consider in the development of the 2021-22 Council Budget.



## **Kennett River Toilets**

The public toilets at Kennett River have reopened in time for the easing of travel restrictions for Regional Victoria and the September school holidays.

Colac Otway Shire will receive funding from DELWP for waste tank pump out.

The toilets opened on Friday, 18 September.

#### Draft Development Plan Submissions Invited

Colac Otway Shire Council has recently received a draft Development Plan for the land at **6230 and 6280 Great** 

Ocean Road, Apollo Bay. A previous Development Plan for the land was refused at the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT) in 2018. The current application seeks to address the issues raised in the VCAT decision.

Council invites the community to make submissions on the amended Development Plan prepared for the land, to help inform its decision. Council recognises the significance of this site being the major entrance to Apollo Bay and is committed to ongoing community engagement and input to the planning process. It should be noted that as there is no statutory process for undertaking public notification on Development Plans, there are also no third party appeal rights (such as appeals to VCAT) for submitters. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, and clearly stating the grounds on which the development plan is supported or opposed. Name and contact details of submitters are required for Council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend Council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions.
