Permits will be issued to people who have, or are seeking to keep more than the prescribed number of animals stipulated in 11.3 unless it is considered that the keeping of the animals would not comply with the General Local Law No. 1 - Part 11.

General Local Law No. 1 - Part 11 states that an owner or occupier of land must not keep or allow to be kept on that land, and any other person must not keep or allow to be kept on the land, any animal, bird, reptile or bee in such a manner as to:

- 11.2 be offensive; or
- 11.2 be dangerous; or
- 11.2 be injurious to health; or
- 11.2 cause a nuisance.

This permit is conditional on the permit holder complying fully with these conditions and any other statutory obligation associated with the activity.

- All areas in which the animal, bird or reptile is kept must be secure and maintained in a clean environment.
- Owners/Occupiers must ensure all waste matter is disposed of in the correct manner so as to prevent any offensive odour from occurring
- All animals must not pose a danger to each other or any other animals.
- All permits are valid for 3 years
- Breaches of the permit conditions may result in the permit being revoked
- All animals must be registered with the Colac Otway Shire.
